

**Disclosure of Officers' Relevant Remuneration and Non-Cash Benefits
for the year ending 31 December 2014**
**(pursuant to s.148 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009
and IEUA Rules Schedule 1 - Governance**

Section 148 of the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 requires organisations to adopt rules relating to the disclosure of remuneration and any material personal interest of those persons holding an elected Office of the Branch.

Disclosure must be made to members of the Branch within 6 months of the end of the financial year.

Disclosure of the identity of the Officers who are the two highest paid Officers of the Branch.

No Officer of the IEUA-QNT Branch received any relevant remuneration or relevant non-cash benefits during the 2014 financial year.

Disclosure of Officers' material personal interests disclosed to the Branch.

- Payment to IEUA - \$90,278 being IR Levies payable for the 2014 financial year;
- Payment to QIEU - \$20,628 reimbursements for administrative expenses.
