Professional Issues Representative

The Professional Issues Representative has the responsibility of providing feedback to our union on matters relating to education initiatives and their implementation in schools.

This role is for you if:

- You are passionate about the implementation of education initiatives
- You aren't afraid to ask questions of leadership about new programs being implemented
- You are detail orientated

Activities include:

- Speaking to staff about becoming a member of their union
- Being a point of contact for IEUA-QNT when asking about specific matters relating to educational issues such as curriculum, assessment/reporting or new initiatives being implemented at the school level
- Being a point of contact for members who have concerns surrounding professional issues at school
- Acting as a contact for beginning educators on matters of professional registration
- Liaising with the Chapter Representative on any professional issues or concerns that require a collective response from the Chapter
